This is the Sukumar family. The father who was a masonry worker previously and is not able to work regularly due to a surgery he had recently. Mrs. Janaki

the mother of three kids joined in a garments company and was struggling to manage the family. She is a good prayer warrior and a spiritual woman from the Bangalore Central Church, our partner. Now FAMIN is taking care of all these three kids Geetha, Sangeetha and Preethi for supporting their basic needs. Isn't it a good answer from God for Janaki's tears and prayers?.

The standard of education is not up to the



required level in the schools run by Government and managements of tea estates at Valparai. These kids are privileged to learn more than the others

and get additional help at the tuition center run by Sis.Lilly Aruldass in her home in Valparai.

Valparai is a small town in the mountain hills "Anamalais" at Coimbatore District. There are 56 tea and coffee estates where most of the family members are employed. The life of people with a very low income and in company provided huts is



critical. Even the basic needs for the children like food, clothing, education can scarcely be met by the parents. The emerging effects of this situations are child-labour environment, mass school drop-outs and illiterate people, anti-social criminals etc. In view of doing something towards this and protect the children and provide their basic needs, we are developing FAMIN work and assistance there. During our stay we arranged meetings and group discussions at Valparai. Please pray for the future works to be carried out at Valparai *[more information about this growing project will follow]*.

Reetha, is a widow with two youths. She is also a tailoring teacher with her colleague Mercy. She is helping women to learn about tailoring and the technical part of sewing cloths in our partner project LIT/BCC in Bangalore. Both are now equipped with portable multifunctional sewing machines.

These girls are dancing to a song about the birth of our Lord Jesus. It was during the Graduation-cum-Christmas celebration held at BCC, Geddalahalli. It is our great joy to know that new graduates can get employment easier. They can also start their own business through making use of this training program - and their diplomas.

Most of the families in South India are living below poverty line and need help. Helanrani with her baby Rebecca and her husband Samuel Loveless are receiving our support. In turn, they will become a future help for their own people. We plan to have them as a houseparent for a home for boys and girls in the Tea Estates in Valparai Tamil Nadu. Pray for them also.
